

La Bohème Canals

Canals

Across Europe and Scandinavia, canals enable boats to traverse the countryside. La Bohème is ideal for trans-navigation by canal, having a relatively shallow draft. To fit in some locks, larger boats must ship their bowsprits, or jib booms. La Bohème is designed for her jib boom to be retracted, as shown in these photos.

1. Simply tie up to a quiet riverbank



2. Stay as close to the foliage as possible



3. Have the team ship the jib boom



4. Dinner aboard, tied up to bushes



5. Arrive at the bottom lock first thing



6. Suddenly, you're heading across the countryside in a 34m / 111' schooner
