The Captain's Jolly Boat

The Jolly Boat was traditionally used exclusively by the Captain on his excursions ashore. To be suitable for purpose, a Jolly Boat would have to be of the finest materials and workmanship. La Bohème's Jolly Boat is no exception - it is a beautifully made and maintained craft. Hung from solid oak davits at the stern, the Jolly Boat is easily managed by one crewman. It also carries a traditional sail and is equipped with a rudder.
